

How Safe is Your Business from a Cyberattack?



Canadian small and mid-sized businesses report decreasing confidence in protecting their data from cyberattacks.

26% of employees are very confident that their organization would be able to keep their business and its information safe from a cyberattack. This represents a seven-point drop year-over-year.

46% of employees believe their business is at risk of experiencing a cyberattack.

14% of employees recognize that they do not spend enough time and money on cybersecurity.

73% of employees believe cyberattacks on businesses have increased within the last year alone.

A lack of education, training and money means companies are not prepared for a cyberattack:



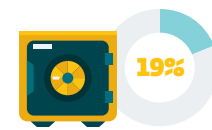
Don't know how their organization could be attacked.
